

For the School Year the Pupil Premium allocation for the school is £ 48160.

This was calculated on 30 pupils eligible for the pupil premium. We currently only have 17 pupils on Free School Meals (FSM) which means that 13 children receive money on Ever 6.

There are 4 Looked after children – adopted from care, in school.

Approximate Pupil premium will be spent on :

£30000	Higher level teaching assistant staff to run targeted learning intervention programmes within morning and afternoon sessions throughout the week.
£5000	Professional interventions, Orretts Meadow Maths & English SEN advisory and assessment team (SENAAT)
£8000	Additional TA support within the classroom to provide training, run intervention programmes for pupil's phonics, socially speaking and social/ emotional programmes of support, motor skills, Lego therapy, handwriting and intensive reading programmes.
£1236	Educational Psychology service for advice, monitoring and guidance.
£1000	Resources and books for the above programmes of additional support within the classrooms
£600	Read, write, Inc. intervention programme materials and training.
£500	Contribution to first access musical instrument tuition (2 terms of learning the cornet), providing quality free music tuition to children who would not normally get access to learning musical instruments.
£500	Payment to FSM pupils (with agreement of the parents)to attend after school clubs, or Gifted and Talented out of school courses to which they otherwise would not gain access-developing both academic, social and emotional qualities of the children.
