## **CONSULTATION ON PROPOSED ACADEMY CONVERSION**

Following many months of research, the governors at Black Horse Hill Junior School have taken the decision to consider applying for academy status and joining Oak Trees Multi Academy Trust ("trust"). You can find out information about the trust at [www.oaktreesmat.co.uk](http://www.oaktreesmat.co.uk). We believe this would benefit our pupils and staff enormously.

### **RATIONALE**

The current educational climate is changing and many schools nationally are choosing to take advantage of academy status. Many schools wish to make the move now to determine their own destiny and to make the changes when it is right for their own school.

As a consequence of the national picture and continued debate and growth of academies in England, the governors have spent some time looking more closely into whether an academy model would be in the best interests of the children, teachers and staff at Black Horse Hill Junior School. The governors are keen that Black Horse Hill Junior School has full control of when and how they go forward with academy status, without pressure from Government departments. As one of a number of schools currently considering academy status, our governors consider that joining the trust now will be a positive step for the school.

### **THE PROPOSAL**

The governing body at Black Horse Hill Junior School believes that the best plan for the school is to become an academy and join Oak Trees Multi Academy Trust.

The Trust was established in June 2017, with four schools joining initially: Poulton Lancelyn Primary School, Egremont Primary School, Stanton Road Primary School and Great Meols Primary School; Church Drive Primary School joined later in 2019; and Brackenwood Junior School joined in 2021. The most recent school to join the trust is Greasby Junior School, which converted on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2023, bringing the total number of schools in the trust to seven. The trust was set up to enhance the good working relationships and practices built up over a number of years between the schools; all current schools were judged at least to be 'good' in terms of OFSTED category.

The Trust has received significant interest from other schools across the area who would like to join; demand has been high especially from those schools that are judged to be good or outstanding by OFSTED. Strengthening our partnerships with these schools would have clear benefits for Black Horse Hill Junior School and the additional support available through a trust model would be one of the advantages of becoming an academy.

The proposal is that Black Horse Hill Junior School converts to academy status and joins the trust on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2024.
