



Maths

Intent - At Black Horse Hill Junior School, we follow the National Curriculum. We intend to provide a curriculum which caters for the needs of all individuals and sets them up with the necessary mathematical skills and knowledge for them for their future lives.

Implementation - This year the implementation is based on White Rose Maths. Our plans will follow the structure of this and will use other resources used to supplement the curriculum. Maths will be taught on a daily basis using a range of teaching styles. Teaching slides will be used to deliver the daily maths lesson. Mental maths activities will be included at the beginning of each lesson. Recaps take place at the beginning of lessons to reinforce any previous learning. Short arithmetic sessions take place in order to further develop the children's basic skills.

Impact - The impact of our Maths curriculum is measured through book scrutiny, data collection and pupil voice interviews, where we talk about the knowledge that they have gained and their enjoyment of subject. The impact can be seen in children's books. Children can demonstrate recall of concepts and skills taught and can see the relevance for life outside of school.
